

# FAQ – ELDT Information

1. There are 3 steps required for a new driver to complete the process to take their CDL driving exam thru DPS or a 3<sup>rd</sup> party testing site. The order of the steps below are recommended.
  - Step #1: **Written tests @ DPS > CLP (permit)**
  - Step #2: **Complete ELDT Theory** – most likely completed online.
  - Step #3: **Complete ELDT Behind the Wheel Training (hands on)**
- These steps can be completed in any order except that Step #1 must be completed before the driver starts their ELDT Behind the Wheel training.
- Driver are not required to use the same ELDT provider for Theory and Behind the Wheel.
- Drivers must complete all 3 steps before they are allowed to take their CDL driving exam @ DPS or a 3<sup>rd</sup> party testing site.

# FAQ – ELDT Theory

2. NTSS can provide the ELDT Theory as listed below.

- NTSS can provide online ELDT Theory for Class B, Passenger and School Bus drivers.
- NTSS Theory for Class B requires the following time commitment (approx. 3 hours), Passenger (3/4 hour), School Bus (3/4 hour).
- NTSS charges a total flat fee of \$125 for ELDT Theory.
- Drivers are required to take an exam at the end of the online training and must make an 80.
- NTSS **does not provide NTSS ELDT Theory for Class A drivers.**
- A driver is not required to use the same provider for ELDT Theory and ELDT Behind the Wheel.

# FAQ – NTSS ELDT Behind the Wheel

2. NTSS can provide ELDT Behind the Wheel services as listed below.

- ELDT Behind the Wheel (BTW) is offered under the following circumstances.

a) **Class B individual drivers** who have access to a Class B CMV (approx. 20 hours). NTSS does not provide individual Class A training.

b) **School district ELDT BTW training** can be offered in 2 ways. Train the individual driver for the district (approx. 20 hours). The most common way that BTW services is provided to school districts is thru training a district trainer (1 day). This method is the most cost effective/long term method for districts to provide ELDT BTW. After training, the district trainer would provide BTW training for their own drivers. The TOT program requires the district to pay a yearly service fee. Example, Oct. 2023 thru Sept. 2024 is \$250

# FAQ – NTSS ELDT Behind the Wheel

c) NTSS can provide an ELDT Behind the Wheel training program to **businesses, cities, counties or other entities**. This training includes **Class A, Class B, Class A&B options**. NTSS offers Class A, Class B, and Class A&B training to in-house trainers. After completing the NTSS training, the trainer would be able to train all future drivers using the NTSS training curriculum. Here are details on the training.

- Class B only - 1 day training
- Class A only – 2 days training
- Class A&B – 2 days training
- All trainings include setting up your location as a ELDT BTW training site, all required manuals and materials to complete BTW training.
